

**RUN OF THE MILL**  
**RULES OF PLAY**

**PLAY SESSION** Your admission to Run of the Mill qualifies you for a play period of 2 hours. This may be enforced during busy periods. Children must be under 12 years of age and less than 1.48 metres (4'10"). Height restrictions have been put in place for the safety and enjoyment of all children.

**SUPERVISION** All children must be accompanied by a responsible adult/guardian for the duration of their session at Run of the Mill. Parents/Guardians are responsible for the behaviour and well-being of the children in their care; they must maintain supervision at all times. The Run of the Mill team are here to help maximise your children's enjoyment from the play experience, they are not however a replacement for parental supervision. Run of the Mill does not accept responsibility for the supervision of children.

**PLAY EQUIPMENT** It is important to read and follow the basic rules on display when using the play frame. Children must go down the slide in the forward facing position. They must not push or be pushed by other children. We recommend that arms are folded when travelling down the slide. Under no circumstances should a child or adult climb the slide from the bottom. There should be no climbing on the nets.

**ADULTS** Adults are permitted to enter the play equipment with a child. Adults must remove shoes and must wear socks at all times on the play equipment.

**FOOD & DRINK** Food (including crisps, raisins, sweets, chewing gum) and drinks are not allowed on the play equipment. We request that food and drink consumption be limited to the café/restaurant eating area. Only food and drink purchased from our restaurant may be consumed on the premises, except for babies who are still weaning.

**CLEANLINESS & HYGIENE** Keeping Run of the Mill clean is extremely important to us. Please inform a member of staff of any spillages or unclean areas. Our toilet/changing facilities are checked regularly, if you are not satisfied, please advise a member of staff. Please use the baby changing facilities provided.

**BEHAVIOUR** Any anti-social or abusive behaviour towards staff or other patrons and any wilful damage to the equipment will not be tolerated at Run of the Mill. Anyone involved will be asked to leave the play centre. This decision is at the discretion of the management and no refund will be offered.

**DRESS CODE** All shoes and other outer footwear must be removed before entering the play area, this applies to adults and children alike. Shoes should be stored in bags or under tables to avoid accidents. Socks must be worn on the play equipment at all times and may be purchased at reception. Jewellery, belts, watches and other items with sharp edges should not be worn when playing on equipment. We recommend to parents that children wear long sleeves and trousers.

**BABY CHANGING & FEEDING** It is not permitted to change nappies in the public area; please use the baby change facilities provided. Run of the Mill will not heat baby food/drink for our patrons. We provide facilities for our patrons to heat their own baby food/milk but we cannot accept responsibility for the temperature of the food after you have heated it. Please check carefully.

**HEALTH** Children who are injured, ill or nauseous are not permitted to use the play frame. We ask that all children use the toilet before using the equipment.

**FIRE** Patrons are not permitted to carry matches, lighters, fireworks or other combustible materials anywhere in the play centre.

**SMOKING** Pear Mill is a non-smoking building. Smoking is not permitted in any part of Run of the Mill or within 10 metres of the main entrance. Smoke detectors are fitted throughout the play centre. Anyone found in breach of this rule will be asked to leave the play centre and no refund will be offered.

**ACCIDENTS** All accidents, however minor, should be reported at reception and recorded in the accident book. Parents/Guardians should note that whilst every consideration has been given for the safety of children using the play equipment, Run of the Mill cannot be held responsible for accidents which occur as a result of children playing on the equipment. It is important to follow the rules of play at all times at Run of the Mill.

**POSSESSIONS** Run of the Mill Play Limited does not accept responsibility or liability for the loss or damage to any personal possessions whilst on the premises or in the car park.

**LIABILITY** Run of the Mill Play Limited does not accept responsibility or liability for loss or injury caused through the misuse of equipment or lack of supervision by a parent/guardian.
